Daze Racial 0

School: Enchantment (Compulsion) [Mind-Affecting] **Components**: V, S, M (a pinch of wool or similar substance)

Casting Time: 1 action Range: Close (25 + 5 ft./2 levels)

Target: One humanoid creature of 4 HD or less

Duration: 1 round Save: DC 14 Will negates Resistance: Yes

This spell clouds the mind of a humanoid creature with 4 or fewer Hit Dice so that it takes no actions. Humanoids of 5 or more HD are not affected. A dazed subject is not stunned, so attackers get no special advantage against it. After a creature has been dazed by this spell, it is immune to the effects of this spell for 1 minute.

Detect Magic Racial 0

School: Divination Components: V, S Casting Time: 1 action Range: 60 ft.

Area: Cone-shaped emanation

Duration: Concentration, up to 1 min./level (D)

Save: None Resistance: No

You detect magical auras. The amount of information revealed depends on how long you study a particular area or subject.

1st Round: Presence or absence of magical auras.

2nd Round: Number of different magical auras and the power of the most potent aura.

3rd Round: The strength and location of each aura. If the items or creatures bearing the auras are in line of sight, you can make Knowledge (arcana) skill checks to determine the school of magic involved in each. (Make one check per aura: DC 15 + spell level, or 15 + 1/2 caster level for a nonspell effect.) If the aura eminates from a magic item, you can attempt to identify its properties (see Spellcraft).

Magical areas, multiple types of magic, or strong local magical emanations may distort or conceal weaker auras.

Aura Strength: An aura's power depends on a spell's functioning spell level or an item's caster level; see the accompanying table. If an aura falls into more than one category, detect magic indicates the stronger of the two.

Lingering Aura: A magical aura lingers after its original source dissipates (in the case of a spell) or is destroyed (in the case of a magic item). If detect magic is cast and directed at such a location, the spell indicates an aura strength of dim (even weaker than a faint aura). How long the aura lingers at this dim level depends on its original power:

Original Strength - Duration of Lingering Aura

Faint - 1d6 rounds Moderate - 1d6 minutes Strong - 1d6 x 10 minutes Overwhelming - 1d6 days

Outsiders and elementals are not magical in themselves, but if they are summoned, the conjuration spell registers. Each round, you can turn to detect magic in a new area. The spell can penetrate barriers, but 1 foot of stone, 1 inch of common metal, a thin sheet of lead, or 3 feet of wood or dirt blocks it.

Detect magic can be made permanent with a permanency spell.

Light Racial 0

School: Evocation / Wood Elemental [Light]

Components: V, M/DF (a firefly) Casting Time: 1 action Range: Touch

Target: Object touched Duration: 10 min./level Save: None

Resistance: No

This spell causes a touched object to glow like a torch, shedding normal light in a 20-foot radius, and increasing the light level for an additional 20 feet by one step, up to normal light (darkness becomes dim light, and dim light becomes normal light). In an area of normal or bright light, this spell has no effect. The effect is immobile, but it can be cast on a movable object. You can only have one light spell active at any one time. If you cast this spell while another casting is still in effect, the previous casting is dispelled. If you make this spell permanent (through permanency or a similar effect), it does not count against this limit.

Light can be used to counter or dispel any darkness spell of equal or lower spell level.

Mage Hand Racial 0

School: Transmutation
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action

Range: Close (25 + 5 ft./2 levels)

Target: One nonmagical, unattended object weighing up to 5 lbs.

Duration: Concentration

Save: None Resistance: No

You point your finger at an object and can lift it and move it at will from a distance. As a move action, you can propel the object as far as 15 feet in any direction, though the spell ends if the distance between you and the object ever exceeds the spell's range.

Open/Close Racial 0

School: Transmutation

Components: V, S, F (a brass key)

Casting Time: 1 action

Range: Close (25 + 5 ft./2 levels)

Target: Object weighing up to 30 lbs. or portal that can be opened or

closed

Duration: Instantaneous

Save: DC 14 Will negates (object)

Resistance: Yes (object)

You can open or close (your choice) a door, chest, box, window, bag, pouch, bottle, barrel, or other container. If anything resists this activity (such as a bar on a door or a lock on a chest), the spell fails. In addition, the spell can only open and close things weighing 30 pounds or less. Thus, doors, chests, and similar objects sized for enormous creatures may be beyond this spell's ability to affect.

Ray of Frost Racial 0

School: Evocation / Water Elemental [Cold]

Components: V, S Casting Time: 1 action

Range: Close (25 + 5 ft./2 levels)

Effect: Ray

Duration: Instantaneous

Save: None Resistance: Yes

A ray of freezing air and ice projects from your pointing finger. You must succeed on a ranged touch attack with the ray to deal damage to a target. The ray deals 1d3 points of cold damage.

Read Magic Racial 0

School: Divination

Components: V, S, F (a clear crystal or mineral prism)

Casting Time: 1 action Range: Personal Target: You

Duration: 10 min./level

You can decipher magical inscriptions on objects - books, scrolls, weapons, and the like - that would otherwise be unintelligible. This deciphering does not normally invoke the magic contained in the writing, although it may do so in the case of a cursed or trapped scroll. Furthermore, once the spell is cast and you have read the magical inscription, you are thereafter able to read that particular writing without recourse to the use of read magic. You can read at the rate of one page (250 words) per minute. The spell allows you to identify a glyph of warding with a DC 13 Spellcraft check, a greater glyph of warding with a DC 16 Spellcraft check, or any symbol spell with a Spellcraft check (DC 10 + spell level).

Read magic can be made permanent with a permanency spell.

Stabilize Racial 0

School: Conjuration (Healing)

Components: V, S Casting Time: 1 action

Range: Close (25 + 5 ft./2 levels)
Target: One living creature
Duration: Instantaneous
Save: Will negates (harmless)
Resistance: Yes (harmless)

Upon casting this spell, you target a living creature that has -1 or fewer hit points. That creature is automatically stabilized and does not lose any further hit points. If the creature later takes damage, it continues dying normally.

Cure Light Wounds Racial 1

School: Conjuration (Healing)

Components: V, S Casting Time: 1 action

Range: Touch

Target: Creature touched Duration: Instantaneous

Save: Will half (harmless); see text **Resistance**: Yes (harmless); see text

When laying your hand upon a living creature, you channel positive energy that cures 1d8 points of damage + 1 point per caster level (maximum +5). Since undead are powered by negative energy, this spell deals damage to them instead of curing their wounds. An undead creature can apply spell resistance, and can attempt a Will save to take half damage.

Divine Favor Racial 1

School: Evocation Components: V, S, DF Casting Time: 1 action Range: Personal Target: You Duration: 1 minute

Calling upon the strength and wisdom of a deity, you gain a +1 luck bonus on attack and weapon damage rolls for every three caster levels you have (at least +1, maximum +3). The bonus doesn't apply

to spell damage.

Expeditious Retreat

School: Transmutation Components: V, S Casting Time: 1 action Range: Personal Target: You

Duration: 1 min./level (D)

This spell increases your base land speed by 30 feet. This adjustment is treated as an enhancement bonus. There is no effect on other modes of movement, such as burrow, climb, fly, or swim. As with any effect that increases your speed, this spell affects your jumping distance (see the Acrobatics skill).

Mage Armor Racial 1

Racial 1

School: Conjuration (Creation) [Force] **Components**: V, S, F (a piece of cured leather)

Casting Time : 1 action

Range: Touch

Target: Creature touched Duration: 1 hour/level (D) Save: Will negates (harmless)

Resistance: No

An invisible but tangible field of force surrounds the subject of a mage armor spell, providing a +4 armor bonus to AC. Unlike mundane armor, mage armor entails no armor check penalty, arcane spell failure chance, or speed reduction. Since mage armor is made of force, incorporeal creatures can't bypass it the way they do normal armor.

Magic Missile Racial 1

School: Evocation [Force] Components: V, S Casting Time: 1 action

Range: Medium (100 + 10 ft./level)

Target: Up to five creatures, no two of which can be more than 15 ft.

apart **Duration**: Instantaneous

Save: None Resistance: Yes

A missile of magical energy darts forth from your fingertip and strikes its target, dealing 1d4+1 points of force damage. The missile strikes unerringly, even if the target is in melee combat, so long as it has less than total cover or total concealment. Specific parts of a creature can't be singled out. Objects are not damaged by the spell. For every two caster levels beyond 1st, you gain an additional missile - two at 3rd level, three at 5th, four at 7th, and the maximum of five missiles at 9th level or higher. If you shoot multiple missiles, you can have them strike a single creature or several creatures. A single missile can strike only one creature. You must designate targets before you check for spell resistance or roll damage.

Detect Thoughts

Racial 2

School: Divination [Mind-Affecting] Components: V, S, F/DF (a copper piece)

Casting Time: 1 action

Range: 60 ft.

Area: Cone-shaped emanation

Duration: Concentration, up to 1 min./level (D)

Save: DC 16 Will negates; see text

Resistance: No

You detect surface thoughts. The amount of information revealed depends on how long you study a particular area or subject.

1st Round: Presence or absence of thoughts (from conscious creatures with Intelligence scores of 1 or higher).

2nd Round: Number of thinking minds and the Intelligence score of each. If the highest Intelligence is 26 or higher (and at least 10 points higher than your own Intelligence score), you are stunned for 1 round and the spell ends. This spell does not let you determine the location of the thinking minds if you can't see the creatures whose thoughts you are detecting.

3rd Round: Surface thoughts of any mind in the area. A target's Will save prevents you from reading its thoughts, and you must cast detect thoughts again to have another chance. Creatures of animal intelligence (Int 1 or 2) have simple, instinctual thoughts. Each round, you can turn to detect thoughts in a new area. The spell can penetrate barriers, but 1 foot of stone, 1 inch of common metal, a thin sheet of lead, or 3 feet of wood or dirt blocks it.

Restoration, Lesser

Racial 2

Racial 2

School: Conjuration (Healing)

Components: V, S Casting Time: 3 rounds Range: Touch

Target: Creature touched **Duration**: Instantaneous Save: Will negates (harmless) Resistance: Yes (harmless)

Lesser restoration dispels any magical effects reducing one of the subject's ability scores or cures 1d4 points of temporary ability damage to one of the subject's ability scores. It also eliminates any fatique suffered by the character, and improves an exhausted condition to fatigued. It does not restore permanent ability drain.

Scorching Ray

School: Evocation / Fire Elemental [Fire]

Components: V, S

Casting Time: 1 action Range: Close (25 + 5 ft./2 levels) Effect: One or more ravs **Duration**: Instantaneous

Save: None Resistance: Yes

You blast your enemies with a searing beam of fire. You may fire one ray, plus one additional ray for every four levels beyond 3rd (to a maximum of three rays at 11th level). Each ray requires a ranged touch attack to hit and deals 4d6 points of fire damage. The rays may be fired at the same or different targets, but all rays must be aimed at targets within 30 feet of each other and fired simultaneously.

Racial 2 See Invisibility

School: Divination / Void Elemental

Components: V, S, M (talc and powdered silver)

Casting Time: 1 action Range: Personal Target: You

Duration: 10 min./level (D)

You can see any objects or beings that are invisible within your range of vision, as well as any that are ethereal, as if they were normally visible. Such creatures are visible to you as translucent shapes, allowing you easily to discern the difference between visible, invisible, and ethereal creatures. The spell does not reveal the method used to obtain invisibility. It does not reveal illusions or enable you to see through opaque objects. It does not reveal creatures who are simply hiding, concealed, or otherwise hard to see.

See invisibility can be made permanent with a permanency spell.

Cure Serious Wounds

Racial 3

School: Conjuration (Healing)

Components: V, S Casting Time: 1 action

Range: Touch

Target: Creature touched **Duration**: Instantaneous

Save: Will half (harmless); see text Resistance: Yes (harmless); see text

This spell functions like cure light wounds, except that it cures 3d8 points of damage + 1 point per caster level (maximum +15).

Dispel Magic Racial 3 Lightning Bolt Racial 3

School: Abjuration / Void Elemental

Components: V, S Casting Time: 1 action

Range: Medium (100 + 10 ft./level)
Target: One spellcaster, creature, or object

Duration: Instantaneous

Save: None Resistance: No

You can use dispel magic to end one ongoing spell that has been cast on a creature or object, to temporarily suppress the magical abilities of a magic item, or to counter another spellcaster's spell. A dispelled spell ends as if its duration had expired. Some spells, as detailed in their descriptions, can't be defeated by dispel magic. Dispel magic can dispel (but not counter) spell-like effects just as it does spells. The effect of a spell with an instantaneous duration can't be dispelled, because the magical effect is already over before the dispel magic can take effect. You choose to use dispel magic in one of two ways: a targeted dispel or a counterspell.

Targeted Dispel: One object, creature, or spell is the target of the dispel magic spell. You make one dispel check (1d20 + your caster level) and compare that to the spell with highest caster level (DC = 11 + the spell's caster level). If successful, that spell ends. If not, compare the same result to the spell with the next highest caster level. Repeat this process until you have dispelled one spell affecting the target, or you have failed to dispel every spell. For example, a 7thlevel caster casts dispel magic, targeting a creature affected by stoneskin (caster level 12th) and fly (caster level 6th). The caster level check results in a 19. This check is not high enough to end the stoneskin (which would have required a 23 or higher), but it is high enough to end the fly (which only required a 17). Had the dispel check resulted in a 23 or higher, the stoneskin would have been dispelled, leaving the fly intact. Had the dispel check been a 16 or less, no spells would have been affected. You can also use a targeted dispel to specifically end one spell affecting the target or one spell affecting an area (such as a wall of fire). You must name the specific spell effect to be targeted in this way. If your caster level check is equal to or higher than the DC of that spell, it ends. No other spells or effects on the target are dispelled if your check is not high enough to end the targeted effect. If you target an object or creature that is the effect of an ongoing spell (such as a monster summoned by summon monster), you make a dispel check to end the spell that conjured the object or creature. If the object that you target is a magic item, you make a dispel check against the item's caster level (DC = 11 + the item's caster level). If you succeed, all the item's magical properties are suppressed for 1d4 rounds, after which the item recovers its magical properties. A suppressed item becomes nonmagical for the duration of the effect. An interdimensional opening (such as a bag of holding) is temporarily closed. A magic item's physical properties are unchanged: A suppressed magic sword is still a sword (a masterwork sword, in fact). Artifacts and deities are unaffected by mortal magic such as this. You automatically succeed on your dispel check against any spell that you cast yourself.

Counterspell: When dispel magic is used in this way, the spell targets a spellcaster and is cast as a counterspell. Unlike a true counterspell, however, dispel magic may not work; you must make a dispel check to counter the other spellcaster's spell.

School: Evocation / Air Elemental / Metal Elemental [Electricity]

Components: V, S, M (fur and a glass rod)

Casting Time : 1 action

Range: 120 ft.
Area: 120-ft. line
Duration: Instantaneous
Save: DC 17 Reflex half
Resistance: Yes

You release a powerful stroke of electrical energy that deals 1d6 points of electricity damage per caster level (maximum 10d6) to each creature within its area. The bolt begins at your fingertips. The lightning bolt sets fire to combustibles and damages objects in its path. It can melt metals with a low melting point, such as lead, gold, copper, silver, or bronze. If the damage caused to an interposing barrier shatters or breaks through it, the bolt may continue beyond the barrier if the spell's range permits; otherwise, it stops at the barrier just as any other spell effect does.

Divine Power Racial 4

School: Evocation Components: V, S, DF Casting Time: 1 action Range: Personal Target: You

Duration: 1 round/level

Calling upon the divine power of your patron, you imbue yourself with strength and skill in combat. You gain a +1 luck bonus on attack rolls, weapon damage rolls, Strength checks, and Strength-based skill checks for every three caster levels you have (maximum +6). You also gain 1 temporary hit point per caster level. Whenever you make a full-attack action, you can make an additional attack at your full base attack bonus, plus any appropriate modifiers. This additional attack is not cumulative with similar effects, such as haste or weapons with the speed special ability.

Invisibility, Greater

Racial 4

School: Illusion (Glamer)

Components: V, S, M/DF (an eyelash encased in gum arabic)
Casting Time: 1 action

Casting Time: 1 action Range: Personal or touch Target: You or creature touched Duration: 1 round/level (D) Save: Will negates (harmless)

Resistance: Yes (harmless) or yes (harmless, object)

This spell functions like invisibility, except that it doesn't end if the

subject attacks.
