When signing in characters at the start of the session, work out which characters are Pathfinder Society agents, using the attached extra information sheet.

If some characters are Pathfinders and some are not, players of Pathfinder characters receive the first handout. These Pathfinders have the task of recruiting extra party members (for example, by visiting the *Crow and Shovel*, a tavern in the Foreign Quarter where it's well-known that adventurers gather to plan their next ventures).

If all or none of the party are Pathfinders, don't use the first handout.

Players of characters who are Pathfinder agents and members of the Sovereign Court or Silver Crusade receive the second or third handout as appropriate.
