Alertness You often notice things that others might miss. Benefit: You get a +2 bonus on Perception and Sense Motive skill checks. If you have 10 or more ranks in one of these skills, the bonus increases to +4 for that skill. Appears In: Not Consolidated Skills	Feat	Weapon Focus (Claw) Choose one type of weapon. Summon (level 3, 1d2 dorus 25%, 1/day) (†Racial Ability (Div, Aghash))

A creature with the summon ability can summon other specific creatures of its kind much as though casting a summon monster spell, but it usually has only a limited chance of success (as specified in the creature's entry). Roll d%: On a failure, no creature answers the summons. Summoned creatures automatically return whence they came after 1 hour. A creature summoned in this way cannot use any spells or spell-like abilities that require material components costing more than 1 gp unless those components are supplied, nor can it use its own summon ability for 1 hour. An appropriate spell level is given for each summoning ability for purposes of Will saves, caster level checks, and concentration checks. No experience points are awarded for defeating summoned monsters.

Telepathy (100 feet) (Su) Unknown

The creature can mentally communicate with any other creature within a certain range (specified in the creature's entry, usually 100 feet) that has a language. It is possible to address multiple creatures at once telepathically, although maintaining a telepathic conversation with more than one creature at a time is just as difficult as simultaneously speaking and listening to multiple people at the same time.

Cackle (Su) Class Ability (Witch)

A witch can cackle madly as a move action. Any creature that is within 30 feet that is under the effects of an agony hex, charm hex, evil eye hex, fortune hex, or misfortune hex caused by the witch has the duration of that hex extended by 1 round.

Appears In: Advanced Player's Guide

Deliver Touch Spells Through Familiar (Su) Class Ability (Witch)

If the master is 3rd level or higher, a familiar can deliver touch spells for him. If the master and the familiar are in contact at the time the master casts a touch spell, he can designate his familiar as the 'toucher'. The familiar can then deliver the touch spell just as the master could. As usual, if the master casts another spell before the touch is delivered, the touch spell dissipates.

Empathic Link with Familiar (Su) Class Ability (Witch)

The master has an empathic link with his familiar out to a distance of up to 1 mile. The master cannot see through the familiar's eyes, but they can communicate empathically. Because of the limited nature of the link, only general emotional content can be communicated.

Because of this empathic link, the master has the same connection to an item or place that his familiar does.

Evil Eye -4 (7 rounds, DC 20) (Su) Class Ability (Witch)

The witch causes doubt to creep into the mind of a foe within 30 feet that she can see. The target takes a -2 penalty on one of the following (witch's choice): ability checks, AC, attack rolls, saving throws, or skill checks. This hex lasts a number of rounds equal to 3 + the witch's Intelligence modifier. A successful Will saving throw reduces this to just 1 round. At 8th level, the penalty increases to -4.

Appears In: Advanced Player's Guide

Familiar Bonus: +3 to Bluff checks Class Ability (Witch)

If you are within arm's reach of your familiar, you gain the benefits of the Alertness feat.

If you are within 1 mile of your familiar, you may gain other benefits.

Fortune (2 rounds) (Su) Class Ability (Witch)

The shaman or witch grants a creature within 30 feet a bit of good luck for 1 round. The target can call upon this good luck once per round, allowing it to reroll any ability check, attack roll, saving throw, or skill check, taking the better result. The target creature must decide to use this ability before the first roll is made. At 8th and 16th levels, the duration of this hex increases by 1 round. Once a creature has benefited from the fortune hex, it cannot benefit from it again for 24 hours.

Appears In: Advanced Player's Guide

Misfortune (2 rounds, DC 20) (Su) Class Ability (Witch)

The shaman or witch causes a creature within 30 feet to suffer grave misfortune for 1 round. Anytime the creature makes an ability check, attack roll, saving throw, or skill check, it must roll twice and take the worse result. A successful Will saving throw negates this hex. At 8th level and 16th level, the duration of this hex is extended by 1 round. This hex affects all rolls the target must make while it lasts. Whether or not the save is successful, the creature cannot be the target of this hex again for 24 hours.

Appears In: Advanced Player's Guide

Scry on Familiar (1/day) (Sp) Class Ability (Witch)

If the master is 13th level or higher, he may scry on his familiar (as if casting the *scrying* spell) once per day.

Share Spells with Familiar Class Ability (Witch)

The wizard may cast a spell with a target of "You" on his familiar (as a touch spell) instead of on himself. A wizard may cast spells on his familiar even if the spells do not normally affect creatures of the familiar's type (magical beast).

Slumber (13 rounds, DC 20) (Su) Class Ability (Witch)

A witch can cause a creature within 30 feet to fall into a deep, magical sleep, as per the spell *sleep*. The creature receives a Will save to negate the effect. If the save fails, the creature falls asleep for a number of rounds equal to the witch's level. This hex can affect a creature of any HD. The creature will not wake due to noise or light, but others can rouse it with a standard action. This hex ends immediately if the creature takes damage. Whether or not the save is successful, a creature cannot be the target of this hex again for 1 day.

Appears In: Advanced Player's Guide

Speak with Animals (Ex) Class Ability (Witch)

If the master is 7th level or higher, a familiar can communicate with animals of approximately the same kind as itself (including dire varieties): bats with bats, rats with rodents, cats with felines, hawks and owls and ravens with birds, lizards and snakes with reptiles, toads with amphibians, weasels with similar creatures (weasels, minks, polecats, ermines, skunks, wolverines, and badgers). Such communication is limited by the intelligence of the conversing creatures.

Speak with Familiar (Ex) Class Ability (Witch)

If the master is 5th level or higher, a familiar and the master can communicate verbally as if they were using a common language. Other creatures do not understand the communication without magical help.

Weather Control (1/day) (Su) Class Ability (Witch)

A witch with this hex can use *control weather* once per day, but creating the weather takes 1 full hour of chanting, dancing, and communing with her familiar.

Wand of lightning bolt (CL 9th, 5 charges) Wand

Lightning Bolt, Reflex Half (DC 14)

You release a powerful stroke of electrical energy that deals 1d6 points of electricity damage per caster level (maximum 10d6) to each creature within its area. The bolt begins at your fingertips. The lightning bolt sets fire to combustibles and damages objects in its path. It can melt metals with a low melting point, such as lead, gold, copper, silver, or bronze. If the damage caused to an interposing barrier shatters or breaks through it, the bolt may continue beyond the barrier if the spell's range permits; otherwise, it stops at the barrier just as any other spell effect does.

Surma 10-11, Witch 13 – Spells

Arcane Mark Witch 0

School: Universal
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Touch
Effect: One personal rune or mark, all of which must fit within 1 sq. ft.
Duration: Permanent
Save: None
Resistance: No

This spell allows you to inscribe your personal rune or mark, which can consist of no more than six characters. The writing can be visible or invisible. An *arcane mark* spell enables you to etch the rune upon any substance without harm to the material upon which it is placed. If an invisible mark is made, a *detect magic* spell causes it to glow and be visible, though not necessarily understandable.

See *invisibility*, *true seeing*, *a gem of seeing*, or *a robe of eyes* likewise allows the user to see an invisible *arcane mark*. A *read magic* spell reveals the words, if any. The mark cannot be dispelled, but it can be removed by the caster or by an *erase* spell.

If an *arcane mark* is placed on a living being, the effect gradually fades in about a month.

Arcane mark must be cast on an object prior to casting *instant summons* on the same object (see that spell description for details).

Bleed Witch 0

School: Necromancy
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Close (25 + 5 ft./2 levels)
Target: One living creature
Duration: Instantaneous
Save: DC 14 Will negates
Resistance: Yes

You cause a living creature that is below 0 hit points but stabilized to resume dying. Upon casting this spell, you target a living creature that has -1 or fewer hit points. That creature begins dying, taking 1 point of damage per round. The creature can be stabilized later normally. This spell causes a creature that is dying to take 1 point of damage.

Guidance Witch 0

School: Divination / Void Elemental
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Touch
Target: Creature touched
Duration: 1 minute or until discharged
Save: Will negates (harmless)
Resistance: Yes

This spell imbues the subject with a touch of divine guidance. The creature gets a +1 competence bonus on a single attack roll, saving throw, or skill check. It must choose to use the bonus before making the roll to which it applies.

Light Witch 0

School: Evocation / Wood Elemental [Light]
Components: V, M/DF (a firefly)
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Touch
Target: Object touched
Duration: 10 min./level
Save: None
Resistance: No

This spell causes a touched object to glow like a torch, shedding normal light in a 20-foot radius, and increasing the light level for an additional 20 feet by one step, up to normal light (darkness becomes dim light, and dim light becomes normal light). In an area of normal or bright light, this spell has no effect. The effect is immobile, but it can be cast on a movable object. You can only have one light spell active at any one time. If you cast this spell while another casting is still in effect, the previous casting is dispelled. If you make this spell permanent (through permanency or a similar effect), it does not count against this limit.

Light can be used to counter or dispel any darkness spell of equal or lower spell level.

Burning Hands (x2) Witch 1

School: Evocation / Fire Elemental [Fire]
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: 15 ft.
Area: Cone-shaped burst
Duration: Instantaneous
Save: DC 15 Reflex half
Resistance: Yes

A cone of searing flame shoots from your fingertips. Any creature in the area of the flames takes 1d4 points of fire damage per caster level (maximum 5d4). Flammable materials burn if the flames touch them. A character can extinguish burning items as a full-round action.

Mage Armor Witch 1

School: Conjuration (Creation) [Force]
Components: V, S, F (a piece of cured leather)
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Touch
Target: Creature touched
Duration: 1 hour/level (D)
Save: Will negates (harmless)
Resistance: No

An invisible but tangible field of force surrounds the subject of a mage armor spell, providing a +4 armor bonus to AC. Unlike mundane armor, mage armor entails no armor check penalty, arcane spell failure chance, or speed reduction. Since mage armor is made of force, incorporeal creatures can't bypass it the way they do normal armor.

A moderate wind (11+ mph), such as from a gust of wind spell, disperses the fog in 4 rounds. A strong wind (21+ mph) disperses the fog in 1 round. A cloud of golden particles covers everyone and everything in the area, causing creatures to become blinded and visibly outlining invisible things for the duration of the spell. All within the area are covered by the dust, which cannot be removed and continues to sparkle until it fades. Each round at the end of their turn blinded creatures may attempt new saving throws to end the blindness effect. Any creature covered by the dust takes a -40 penalty on Stealth checks.		You can see any objects or beings that are invisible within your range of vision, as well as any that are ethereal, as if they were normally visible. Lightning Bolt (x3)**Witch 3**

School: Evocation / Air Elemental / Metal Elemental [Electricity]
Components: V, S, M (fur and a glass rod)
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: 120 ft.
Area: 120-ft. line
Duration: Instantaneous
Save: DC 17 Reflex half
Resistance: Yes

You release a powerful stroke of electrical energy that deals 1d6 points of electricity damage per caster level (maximum 10d6) to each creature within its area. The bolt begins at your fingertips. The lightning bolt sets fire to combustibles and damages objects in its path. It can melt metals with a low melting point, such as lead, gold, copper, silver, or bronze. If the damage caused to an interposing barrier shatters or breaks through it, the bolt may continue beyond the barrier if the spell's range permits; otherwise, it stops at the barrier just as any other spell effect does.

Stinking Cloud**Witch 3**

School: Conjuraton / Earth Elemental (Creation)
Components: V, S, M (a rotten egg or cabbage leaves)
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Medium (100 + 10 ft./level)
Effect: Cloud spreads in 20-ft. radius, 20 ft. high
Duration: 1 round/level
Save: DC 17 Fortitude negates; see text
Resistance: No

Stinking cloud creates a bank of fog like that created by fog cloud, except that the vapors are nauseating. Living creatures in the cloud become nauseated. This condition lasts as long as the creature is in the cloud and for 1d4+1 rounds after it leaves. (Roll separately for each nauseated character.) Any creature that succeeds on its save but remains in the cloud must continue to save each round on your turn. This is a poison effect.

Stinking cloud can be made permanent with a permanency spell. A permanent stinking cloud dispersed by wind reforms in 10 minutes.

Vampiric Touch**Witch 3**

School: Necromancy
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Touch
Target: Living creature touched
Duration: Instantaneous/1 hour; see text
Save: None
Resistance: Yes

You must succeed on a melee touch attack. Your touch deals 1d6 points of damage per two caster levels (maximum 10d6). You gain temporary hit points equal to the damage you deal. You can't gain more than the subject's current hit points + the subject's Constitution score (which is enough to kill the subject). The temporary hit points disappear 1 hour later.

Cure Serious Wounds**Witch 4**

School: Conjuraton (Healing)
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Touch
Target: Creature touched
Duration: Instantaneous
Save: Will half (harmless); see text
Resistance: Yes (harmless); see text

This spell functions like *cure light wounds*, except that it cures 3d8 points of damage + 1 point per caster level (maximum +15).

Cure Light Wounds

When laying your hand upon a living creature, you channel positive energy that cures 1d8 points of damage + 1 point per caster level (maximum +5). Since undead are powered by negative energy, this spell deals damage to them instead of curing their wounds. An undead creature can apply spell resistance, and can attempt a Will save to take half damage.

Enervation (x2)**Witch 4**

School: Necromancy
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Close (25 + 5 ft./2 levels)
Effect: Ray of negative energy
Duration: Instantaneous
Save: None
Resistance: Yes

You point your finger and fire a black ray of negative energy that suppresses the life force of any living creature it strikes. You must make a ranged touch attack to hit. If you hit, the subject gains 1d4 temporary negative levels (see Appendix 1). Negative levels stack. Assuming the subject survives, it regains lost levels after a number of hours equal to your caster level (maximum 15 hours). Usually, negative levels have a chance of becoming permanent, but the negative levels from enervation don't last long enough to do so. An undead creature struck by the ray gains 1d4 x 5 temporary hit points for 1 hour.

Phantasmal Killer (x2)**Witch 4**

School: Illusion (Phantasm) [Fear, Mind-Affecting]
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Medium (100 + 10 ft./level)
Target: One living creature
Duration: Instantaneous
Save: DC 18 Will disbelief, then Fortitude partial; see text
Resistance: Yes

You create a phantasmal image of the most fearsome creature imaginable to the subject simply by forming the fears of the subject's subconscious mind into something that its conscious mind can visualize: this most horrible beast. Only the spell's subject can see the *phantasmal killer*. You see only a vague shape. The target first gets a Will save to recognize the image as unreal. If that save fails, the phantasm touches the subject, and the subject must succeed on a Fortitude save or die from fear. Even if the Fortitude save is successful, the subject takes 3d6 points of damage.

If the subject of a *phantasmal killer* attack succeeds in disbelieving and possesses telepathy or is wearing a *helm of telepathy*, the beast can be turned upon you. You must then disbelieve it or become subject to its deadly fear attack.

Cure Critical Wounds

Witch 5

School: Conjuration (Healing)
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Touch
Target: Creature touched
Duration: Instantaneous
Save: Will half (harmless); see text
Resistance: Yes (harmless); see text

This spell functions like *cure light wounds*, except that it cures 4d8 points of damage + 1 point per caster level (maximum +20).

Cure Light Wounds

When laying your hand upon a living creature, you channel positive energy that cures 1d8 points of damage + 1 point per caster level (maximum +5). Since undead are powered by negative energy, this spell deals damage to them instead of curing their wounds. An undead creature can apply spell resistance, and can attempt a Will save to take half damage.

Mind Fog

Witch 5

School: Enchantment / Void Elemental (Compulsion) [Mind-Affecting]
Components: V, S
Casting Time: 1 action
Range: Medium (100 + 10 ft./level)
Effect: Fog spreads in 20-ft. radius, 20 ft. high
Duration: 30 minutes and 2d6 rounds; see text
Save: DC 19 Will negates
Resistance: Yes

Mind fog produces a bank of thin mist that weakens the mental resistance of those caught in it. Creatures in the mind fog take a -10 penalty on Wisdom checks and Will saves. (A creature that successfully saves against the fog is not affected and need not make further saves even if it remains in the fog.) Affected creatures take the penalty as long as they remain in the fog and for 2d6 rounds thereafter. The fog is stationary and lasts for 30 minutes (or until dispersed by wind). A moderate wind (11+ mph) disperses the fog in 4 rounds; a strong wind (21+ mph) disperses the fog in 1 round. The fog is thin and does not significantly hamper vision.

Summon Monster V

Witch 5

School: Conjuration / All Elements (Summoning)
Components: V, S, F/DF
Casting Time: 1 round
Range: Close (25 + 5 ft./2 levels)
Effect: One summoned creature
Duration: 1 round/level (D)
Save: None
Resistance: No

This spell functions like *summon monster I*, except that you can summon one creature from the 5th-level list, 1d3 creatures of the same kind from the 4th-level list, or 1d4+1 creatures of the same kind from a lower-level list.
